<b>Kids Marathon Initial payment</b>	YR-6  <b>Cost: £91.00</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To raise the fitness levels of whole school through regular weekly running</li> <li>To give a sense of inspiration and achievement to children in aiming to complete a marathon through the year.</li> <li>To develop opportunities at lunchtimes for sport and cooperation through use of our sports coach to encourage and lead Marathon participation supporting our child sports leaders from Beech and Willow classes.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Whole school participation – all children have taken part to some extent, some are much more enthusiastic than others.</li> <li>We still have 3 months to go and already we have one completed marathon, 1 at ¾ of a marathon, 8 at ½ marathon and 54% of children completed at least 10k with many more close to this.</li> <li>Certificates given to half and full marathon children by Kids Run free</li> </ul>
<b>Swimming Coaching</b>	Years 1-6  <b>Cost £1,251.47</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Qualified swimming coach to take one weekly lesson with all children from Y1 – Y6.</li> <li>All children in school gain water confidence and a good standard of swimming technique before they leave Northchapel.</li> <li>High quality teaching ensures rapid progression in skills and water confidence across the school.</li> <li>CPD for three members of staff observing swimming teaching from a qualified coach.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Confidence of all children in the pool has improved, seen through participation in swimming gala.</li> <li>We are seeing increasing confidence in every child with swimming skills. A very high level of children leave our school as confident swimmers.</li> <li>The quality of children's strokes and swimming technique has improved through effective teaching by qualified swimming coach.</li> <li>Annual swimming gala in which all children take part.</li> </ul>
<b>PPA Multi Sport &amp; Sport Leader Training</b>	Years R-6 Plus playtime provision of sports leader games for the rest of the school.  <b>Cost £3,314.10</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Qualified sports coach leads Young Sports Leader training with 10 children from KS2, followed by supervised sessions for the young leaders to organise and run games for other children in the school at lunch times, improving quality of lunchtime provision and enabling the 10 children to develop leadership skills for the future.</li> <li>Qualified sports coach leads Staff PPA cover sessions enabling children to experience a range of sports not accessible otherwise in school including hockey, basketball, fencing and tennis.</li> <li>This year included weekly sessions with a sports coach for Key Stage 1 and Reception classes to improve Speed, Agility</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sports leaders are enthusiastic and now run games sessions both on days when the sports coach is in school but also other lunch times. These young sports leaders have gained important leadership skills and confidence plus improving lunchtimes through cooperative games for younger children.</li> <li>All children in school now experience high quality sports teaching and opportunity to take part in a range of other sports.</li> <li>Staff in Key Stage 1 and Reception gain CPD from working alongside the sports coach in lessons.</li> <li>The sports coach runs an after school sports club which</li> </ul>

<b>Outdoor educational and adventurous activity</b>	Reception Class  <b>Cost £1,725.61</b>	<p>Provide an opportunity for children in Oak Class (Reception) to take part in Forest School fortnightly with a qualified Forest School leader.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CPD opportunity for teacher and TA to observe and work alongside FS leader.</li> <li>Enrichment and confidence building activities outdoors, including tree climbing, discovering the local environment, tree and plant recognition, art and design based activities and learning to use tools.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All children in school now benefit from Forest School learning which is a strength of our school.</li> <li>Enthusiastic and motivated children who love to learn outside, bringing their ideas, skills and learning back into the classroom.</li> <li>Allows the teacher to build in cooperation, turn taking, working with a partner and one to one work with our youngest children, improving behaviour and enjoyment of learning.</li> </ul>
<b>Skipping workshop</b>	Years R-6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One day skipping workshop with qualified skipping coach</li> <li>Improve enjoyment and skill in skipping to further develop skipping as a playtime activity.</li> <li><b>Cost £200 not yet invoiced – to come out of next year's allocations.</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Every child took part in a one hour high energy skipping workshop followed up with a demonstration to parents of new skipping skills. Many children achieved rapid progress in skipping skills and skipping is now a regular feature of playtime games leading to positive playtimes and greater child fitness.</li> </ul>
