

Please choose 2 topic based piece of homework to be completed and handed in before half term. Use your imagination and creativity, but remember to include wonderful writing, perfect punctuation, super spelling and lovely letter formation.

<p><b><u>How rocks are made</u></b>          Select a type of rock – Metamorphic, Igneous or sedimentary. Draw a diagram and write a simple description of how that type of rock is made. Try and use some scientific vocabulary if you can.</p>	<p><b><u>Volcanoes</u></b>          Research a famous volcano. Create a model or fact sheet on this volcano. Can you explain how it is formed? Can you describe the different parts of it? Can you research and additional interesting facts?</p>	<p><b><u>Book Review</u></b>          Write a book review comparing two books you have read. How were they similar and how were they different? What did you like and dislike about them? Add as much detail as possible.</p>
<p><b><u>Fossil</u></b>          Select 2 fossils that interest you. Give information about what they are, how old they are and how they were made. Try and find some other interesting facts about them too.</p>	<p><b><u>Fossils quiz</u></b>          Create a quiz about fossils, thinking about key facts and come up with some questions you can ask about them that the class could answer. Make up at least 8 questions and an answer sheet too.</p>	<p><b><u>Science Experiment</u></b>          Research and carry out an experiment into different materials. You can choose your own experiment by researching, then write a brief set of instructions and a conclusion to explain your findings. You might like to find out which material is best for a certain job, like being waterproof or keeping something warm.</p>
<p><b><u>Photograph portfolio</u></b>          Create a portfolio of 5 pictures you have taken yourself, explain why you have taken them, what you like about them and how you would make them even better if you took them again.</p>	<p><b><u>PowerPoint</u></b>          Choose a topic you are passionate about, for example a sport, animal, place etc... Create a PowerPoint at least 5 slides long, with accompanying information about your topic. Rehearse this so it can be presented to the rest of the class.</p>	<p><b><u>Write a persuasive letter</u></b>          Write a persuasive letter to a Tutankhamun to explain why you think you would make a good Egyptian ruler. Think about what he was like as a leader and why you might be a good candidate to take over from him. Make sure you are creative with your sentences, and remember the basics.</p>
