Please choose 2 topic-based pieces of homework to be completed and handed in before half term. Use your imagination and creativity, but remember to include wonderful writing, perfect punctuation, super spelling and lovely letter formation.

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| <p><u>Famous</u> Select a famous Anglo-Saxon, Pict or Scot that interests you. Research them and create a fact file about them with interesting details you have found out. Can you create a picture of them to share with the class?</p> | <p><u>Anglo Saxon Clothing</u> To investigate the clothing of Anglo Saxons. Research what kinds of clothes the men or women used to wear in Anglo Saxon times. Draw a diagram to show what they looked like and draw labels to give more information, such as: What the clothing was called, what it was made from and how it was made. Add as much detail as possible.</p> | <p><u>Book Review</u> Write a book review about a fantasy book you have read recently. What was your favourite part and why? Who was your favourite character? Where is the book set and how are these settings described? Can you think of an alternative ending?</p> |
| <p><u>Jazz</u> Investigate a selection of jazz music. Choose one song that you like the most. You can either rehearse it and perform it to the class, or write a review about your chosen song. What do you like about it and why? How does it make you feel? How could you improve it? What are your favourite lyrics?</p> | <p><u>Forces and Magnets quiz</u> Create a quiz about forces and magnets, thinking about key facts and come up with some questions you can ask about them that the class could answer. Make up at least 8 questions and an answer sheet too.</p> | <p><u>Science Experiment</u> Research and carry out an experiment into magnets and forces. You can choose your own experiment by researching, then write a brief set of instructions and a conclusion to explain your findings. You might like to find out how magnets react in different situations, or how magnets are used in everyday items.</p> |
| <p><u>Photograph portfolio</u> Create a portfolio of 5 pictures you have taken yourself, explain why you have taken them, what you like about them and how you would make them even better if you took them again.</p> | <p><u>PowerPoint</u> Choose a topic you are passionate about, for example a sport, animal, place etc... Create a PowerPoint at least 5 slides long, with accompanying information about your topic. Rehearse this so it can be presented to the rest of the class.</p> | <p><u>Write a poem about the Anglo-Saxon, Pict or Scots</u> Write a poem about either the Anglo-Saxons, Picts or Scots. Think about what life was like then and some interesting detail you can add in. Make sure you are creative with your sentences, but keep them short and snappy.... And remember the basics.</p> |
