Science

Evolution & Inheritance:

To recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary, to identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment. To understand that adaptation of plants and animals to suit their environment may lead to evolution; Darwin. To recognise that living things have changed over time, and to understand how humans have evolved over time.

Maths

Year 6 – Fractions, decimals, algebra, statistics, measure (units) and ratio

Year 4/5 - Fractions, decimals, multiplication and division, percentages and statistics.

Computing

Online Safety:

Spam, sites to cite, powerful passwords, false photography, online safety story-telling, online safety comics.

This unit introduces learners to the creation of websites for a chosen purpose. Learners identify what makes a good web page and use this information to design and evaluate their own website using Google Sites. Throughout the process learners pay specific attention to copyright and fair use of media, the aesthetics of the site, and navigation paths.
