

## Grasshopper homework grid Summer 1 2025

Please choose 2 topic-based pieces of homework to be completed and handed in before half term. Use your imagination and creativity, but remember to include wonderful writing, perfect punctuation, super spelling and lovely letter formation.

<p><b><u>Famous:</u></b> Select a famous Roman that interests you. Research them and create a fact file about them with interesting details you have found out. Can you create a picture of them to share with the class?</p>	<p><b><u>If you were a Roman Emperor:</u></b> If you were a Roman Emperor what new laws would you make and why? Make a list of your rules with reasons – this can be presented in any way.</p>	<p><b><u>Book Review:</u></b> Write a book review about a non-fiction book you have read recently. What was your favourite part and why? What was your favourite piece of learning from the book and why? Do you notice anything specific about how it is set out? Which is your favourite page and why? Are there any words that you are not sure of their meaning- look some up using a dictionary and record these.</p>
<p><b><u>Roman recipe:</u></b> Find a Roman Recipe. Make the recipe and take a photo of your creation. Write down the recipe following the structure of instruction writing. Include a section for “What you need” and “What you do”, using bullet points and numbers respectively.</p>	<p><b><u>Plants quiz:</u></b> Create a quiz about plants, thinking about key facts and come up with some questions you can ask about them that the class could answer. You might like to focus your quiz on certain areas, such as: parts of a plant and their purpose, adaptations of plants, types of plants and where they are found, plant identification. Make up at least 8 questions and an answer sheet too.</p>	<p><b><u>Roman inventions:</u></b> The Romans were good at inventions. Investigate and research at least 5 things that they invented. Write about each one and share with the class.</p>
<p><b><u>Signs of summer photograph portfolio:</u></b> Create a portfolio of 5 pictures you have taken yourself that show signs of summer. Explain why you have taken them, and how they illustrate the summer season. This about how you describe them in order to create that picture in the viewers head. How do they make you feel and any interesting details about them.</p>	<p><b><u>PowerPoint:</u></b> Choose a topic you are passionate about, for example a sport, animal, place etc... Create a PowerPoint at least 5 slides long, with accompanying information about your topic. Rehearse this so it can be presented to the rest of the class.</p>	<p><b><u>Create a Roman:</u></b> Come up with your own Roman Name and draw yourself as a Roman – you can be any type of Roman: soldier, emperor, slave, gladiator – label what you are wearing or carrying.</p>
