### Topic: 'We Are Going on a... Hunt'

For this half term's topic we will be scavenging, collecting and finding. The expectation is that there are weekly 'Must Do' tasks and then 'Additional Topic Tasks' which we would like the children to choose from. Homework can be brought in to share on a **Monday** morning.

Tasks I **must** do every week:

<p><b>Reading</b>          Read to an adult, or have them read to you for a <b>minimum of 10 minutes four times per week.</b></p> <p>Please bring your reading record and reading books to school every day. <p>Pick a tree to photograph AND sketch – can you identify it?  <b>CHALLENGE:</b> Can you find an interesting fact about the tree?</p>	<p>How do you celebrate birthdays at home? Do you have any 'rituals'? Pick your own way of presenting this. For example a poster, film, fact sheet or object bag.</p>
<p>Conduct a minibeast hunt in your garden or natural space such as a rotting tree.</p>	
<p>Write or tell a new version of 'We Are Going On A Bear Hunt' with sound effects. For example, 'We Are Going On A Zoo Hunt'.</p>	<p>Plant a seed and care for it – can you keep a growing diary?</p>
