

Please choose **three** topic-based pieces of homework to be completed and handed in before the half-term holidays. Use your imagination and creativity, but remember to include wonderful writing, perfect punctuation, super spelling and lovely letter formation.

<p><b><u>English</u></b>          Create a poem about a river – it doesn't have to rhyme and it can take any form you like: narrative, acrostic, limerick etc.          Learn it and then either recite it to the class or ask someone to video you reciting it.</p> <p>Read another book (fiction or non-fiction book) about rivers and write a book review to present to the class.</p>	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b>          Research a British river and then create an A4 tourist information poster about it. Include lots of detail, including: where is its source? Where does it end? What interesting features does it have? What villages, towns or cities can you find along its route? Illustrate your poster, making it <b>bold, colourful</b> and <b>creative</b>.</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b>          Create a model to demonstrate the forces that act on different objects such as a car driving along a street, a ball being thrown into the air, an aeroplane flying through the sky or a person swimming in the sea. What materials could you use? How would you show a pulling force and/or a pushing force? Your model must be able to stand on a piece of paper <i>no bigger than A3</i> – no exceptions!</p>
<p><b><u>Persuasive Poster</u></b>          Create an A4 poster promoting peace. It can be about peace in general, it could be promoting world peace or it could even be about how to achieve peace between two siblings! Illustrate your poster, making it <b>bold, colourful</b> and <b>creative</b>.</p>	<p><b><u>Online Safety Presentation</u></b>          Create a PowerPoint presentation, of no more than 5 slides, explaining why passwords are important and how to create a strong password          Make sure that you practice it as you will be presenting it to the class!</p>	<p><b><u>PSHRE</u></b>          Research and create a fact file about an influential person who is famous for promoting and educating people about diversity in Great Britain. Who are they? What did they do? What were their key messages? What (if any) recognition did they get for their work?</p>
<p><b><u>Bridges</u></b>          Make a 3D model of any world-famous bridge! You can use Lego, K'Nex etc. or be adventurous with your materials – is it possible to make it out of papier maché or dough? Your model must be able to stand on a piece of paper <i>no bigger than A3</i> – no exceptions!</p>	<p><b><u>Computing</u></b>          Using any programming language (Python, Scratch, Crumble, BBC Micro:bit etc.) write some code to control a device or devices. Can you include sound, light movement etc?</p>	<p><b><u>Music</u></b>          Write and perform or ask someone to video you performing a piece of music around the theme of peace. Collaborate with a friend - or even a group of friends - or work on it alone. It can be an instrumental piece or have lyrics.</p>
